

WHY IS IONA ABBEY SO IMPORTANT?

For almost 1,500 years since St. Columba established this Christian outpost, pilgrims, kings and commoners have come seeking sanctuary, respite and illumination on Iona. Since 1938, the Iona Community has taken up the mantle of St. Columba to offer a place of worship, inspiration and learning in the rebuilt Abbey living spaces.

Each week, community emerges as guests, staff and volunteers share tasks, worship, conversation and meals. Over the course of each season some 3,000 people from around the world, of all faiths and none, come to participate in that community experience. Many of the annual 110,000 day-visitors to the island are also welcomed to worship at the Abbey Church.

WHY IS THIS PROJECT SO IMPORTANT?

This project is complex and exciting; one which involves buildings but is ultimately about people. We will create sustainable and flexible spaces more suited to our programmes and vision and will provide hospitality and inspiration for many generations to come.
