**Time Commitment** 4 Meetings per year – held quarterly by Zoom.

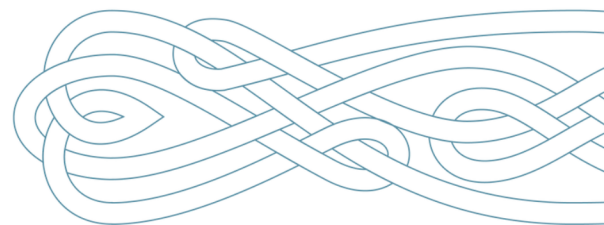
## Overview of the organisation

The Iona Community is an international, ecumenical Christian movement working for justice and peace, the rebuilding of community and the renewal of worship. We long for a just and peaceful world in which all of life can flourish. We are motivated by Christian commitment and seek to work with others who share our vision and purpose.

Our Community was founded in Glasgow, Scotland in 1938 by Rev George MacLeod, a visionary and social reformer.

## Overview of the Community Life Committee

The purpose of the Community Life Committee (CLC) is to give strategic and policy direction to our membership, centres, youth work and wider movement, within the overall purpose and priorities of the Community as set by Council and in Plenaries. The CLC will monitor and support the Community's staff in the development and implementation of this purpose and will liaise closely with the Community Resources Committee to ensure cooperative understanding of their respective areas of responsibility within the Community's life and work. The CLC is responsible to Council for overseeing and encouraging.

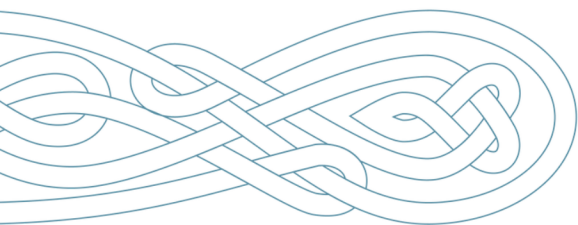
We have identified the following skills which would strengthen the Council:
