29 NOV: the UN Day of Solidarity

In 1977 the UN called for observance of 29 November as the <u>International Day of Solidarity</u> with the Palestinian People.

How to mark the Day of Solidarity?

- Host a video and discussion using the list below.
- Plant a tree: Al-Makhrour is a West Bank area <u>under threat</u>. The "Save al-Makhrour" campaign <u>proposes</u> that from 29th November to 1st December, we join a global "Planting peace" weekend in remembrance of all stolen Palestinian lands.

ADVENT

Liturgical ideas for your church

- Leave the second Advent candle unlit throughout Advent and Christmas. This symbolic action was adopted by many churches in 2023 to stand alongside our sisters and brothers in the Holy Land
- Plan a thought-provoking nativity scene. You might wish to recreate the <u>example of</u> the <u>Evangelical Lutheran Church in Bethlehem</u> with Christ under the rubble.
- **Sing social justice-themed carols and liturgies.** Check out <u>Wild Goose Publications</u> for inspiration.
- **Preach Palestine.** You'll find sermon starters in resources provided by <u>Friends of Sabeel North America</u> (FOSNA).

Take part in events

- Palestine-Longing for Peace is a four-part Advent series facilitated by Sabeel-Kairos.
- Amos Trust Christmas Tour 2024. An evening of music, film, poetry and conversation with special guests from Palestine from 29th November to 6th December.

WRITE TO POLITICIANS

There is no shortage of urgent reasons to write to or meet with your elected representative. You can:

- Demand an end to all arms supply to Israel
- Call on governments to join Norway in asking the UN to <u>clarify Israel's obligations</u> under international law.



In the UK

- Ask MPs to sign the <u>Early Day motion on settlement and sanctions</u> and congratulate those who do.
- Write to Keir Starmer to demand the he uses every lever to pressure Israel to <u>halt its</u> <u>liquidation</u> of the north of Gaza

In USA

- Petition your lawmaker about HR 9495. On 12th November 2024, the House of Representatives voted on a bill that would have allowed the Treasury Secretary the ability to effectively shut down any nonprofit organization they deem "terrorist supporting" by removing tax-exempt status. The motion failed. Use this <u>template letter</u> to influence your elected representative before the next vote.
- Campaign with <u>FOSNA</u>. You'll find more advocacy options at Friends of Sabeel North America.

From Balfour to Banksy (2020)

UK artist, Banksy, created murals on the separation barrier and refurbished the Walled Off Hotel near Bethlehem.

"The long term-effects the British Empire's colonialist enterprises in the modern day region of Israel and Palestine and its role in creating the legacy of division that remains there today".

Law and the Prophets

Even just the first 7 minutes conveys the simple basis of the situation in Israel/Palestine.

Stone-cold justice

This video reports the treatment and detention of children, showing life in the West Bank through the voices of Israelis and Palestinians.

How Israeli Apartheid Destroyed My Hometown

Dena spends a day in Hebron retracing the footsteps of her father, who was born and raised in Hebron. She talks to Palestinians who are subjected to daily harassment from the Israeli military and settlers. And she is guided through the city by former Israeli soldiers, who tell her why their conscience is now forcing them to speak out against the occupation.

War crimes in Gaza

Al Jazeera exposes Israeli war crimes in the Gaza Strip through the medium of photos and videos posted online by Israeli soldiers themselves.
